Konstantin Manaev is not only an internationally sought-after soloist, but also a passionate pedagogue, mentor and musical thinker who continuously builds new bridges within today's classical music world. As a soloist, he has performed on some of the world's most prestigious stages, including the Musikverein Wien and Konzerthaus Berlin, collaborating with renowned orchestras and conductors. He is the founder and artistic director of the internationally recognized Romberg Festival at Schloss Harkotten as well as the Romberg Cello Competition in Münster. Manaev's artistic and pedagogical background is deeply rooted in the great cello tradition connected to Mstislav Rostropovich. All of his principal teachers belonged to Rostropovich's artistic lineage, passing on a unique combination of technical excellence, musical freedom and expressive depth through generations of cello playing.
